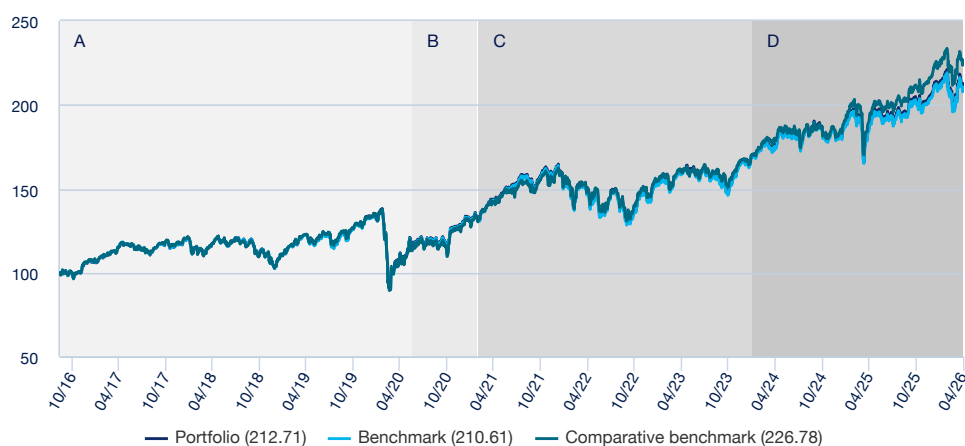

Description of the Index

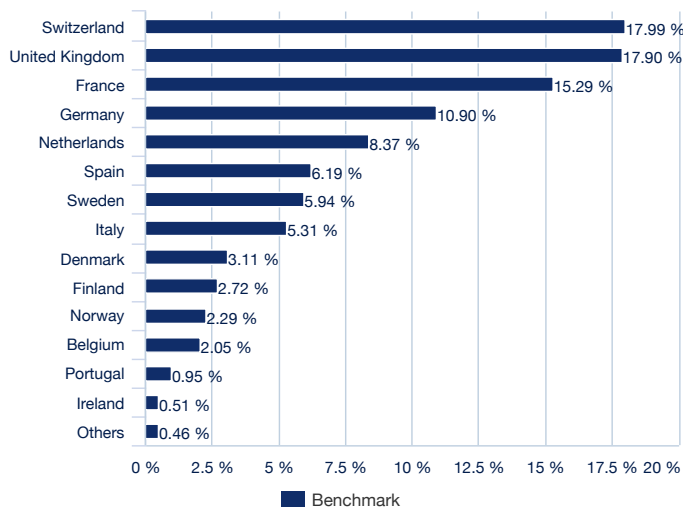
The Index is an equity index based on the MSCI Europe index ("Parent Index") representative of the large and mid-cap stocks across developed market countries in the European Economic and Monetary Union (the "Parent Index"). The Index is designed to support investors seeking to reduce their exposure to transition and physical climate risks and who wish to pursue opportunities arising from the transition to a lower-carbon economy, while aligning with the minimum standards for EU Paris-Aligned Benchmark (EU PABs) under Regulation (EU) 2019/2089 amending Regulation (EU) 2016/1011. The Index incorporates the Task Force on Climate-Related Financial Disclosures (TCFD) recommendations and are designed to exceed the minimum standards of the EU Paris-Aligned Benchmark.

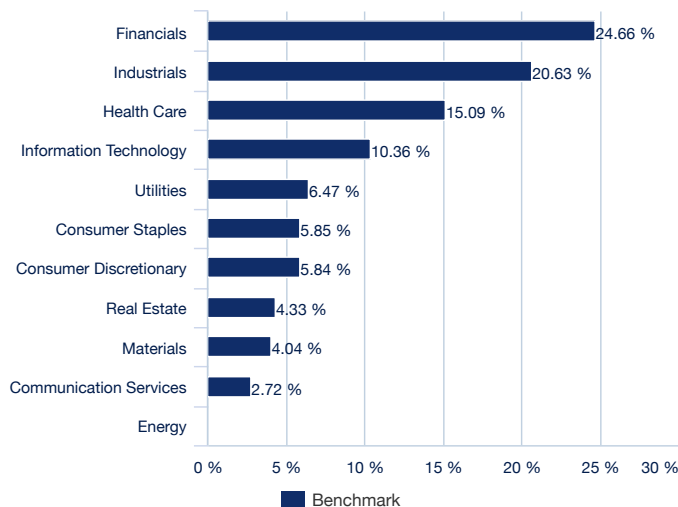

Management commentary

The European economy has been hit hard by the energy shock. Growth in the first quarter came in at 0.8% year-on-year, below forecasts. April data confirm the slowdown in activity. Outlook in the services sector is deteriorating (particularly in Germany), while indicators in the manufacturing sector (production and orders) are more positive, probably linked to preventive restocking by manufacturers fearing price increases and shortages. Consumer confidence is also deteriorating (indicator close to historic lows). The eurozone unemployment rate remained unchanged at 6.2%.

Eurozone inflation rose more than expected, reaching 3% in April, compared to 2.60% in March 2026 (revised up by +0.1 pt), but core inflation has not yet reacted and only increased to 2.2%. Lacking visibility, the European Central Bank kept its key interest rates unchanged (2% for the deposit rate).

Equity markets rebounded strongly in April, with global indices rising by 9 to 10% and volatility decreasing (VIX<17%) after the announcement of the ceasefire in Iran. Europe, weakened by the blockade of the Strait of Hormuz and a new major energy shock, significantly underperformed (Eurostoxx50 +5.6%) with a rise in the euro. Several European companies reported disappointing results. Hermès shares fell by 10% after announcing a drop in sales, as consumers cut back on spending amid the conflict in the Middle East. The DAX30 (+7.1%) significantly outperformed the CAC40 (+3.8%).

Oil prices experienced high volatility throughout April, fluctuating in response to the conflict between Iran and the United States. Brent prices had dropped to \$90 per barrel with the announcement of the ceasefire at the beginning of the month, then rose above \$110 per barrel after the White House reiterated its "red lines" in negotiations with Tehran and ships were hit by gunfire.

The dollar initially appreciated, then followed a downward trend, particularly against the Euro.

Gold continues its consolidation, ending at \$4,618 per ounce in April, after falling by -11.5% in March.
